We are able to pack-out, assess, stabilize, remediate and restore. We restore works of art, original frames and custom framed art from damage due to neglect, breakage, fire, and water.

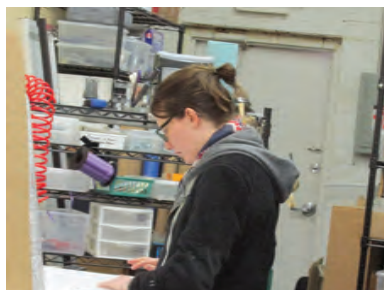
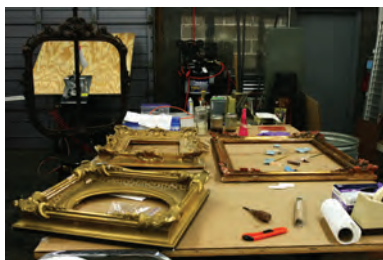


All work is completed in our on-site studio, by our own staff. We do not send items out/we are not “middle-men”. Occasionally when warranted we do work on location with our mobile team.
